

## **IZOD IMPACT TEST**


Material: Mild steel

**OBJECTIVE:** To find the impact resistance of mild steel



Very high stresses at the end of the crack produce local yielding of the material and local plastic flow at the crack tip. This has a action of blunting the sharp tip of the crack
